

Privacy notice of Nougat

In case you are providing your personal data, we as a data controller – Nougat s. r. o., registered office: Hattalova 8, Bratislava - mestská časť Nové Mesto 831 03, ID: 51 161 435, registered with the commercial register of the District Court Bratislava I, section: Sro, file number: 123738/B (hereinafter referred to as the „**Nougat**“ or „**our company**“), would like to inform you about the processing of your personal data and we also inform you of your rights related to the said processing.

In this Privacy notice you can find information about the purpose and legal basis of personal data processing, to whom we may provide your personal data, where you can obtain information about your personal data that we process, or about your individual rights concerning the protection of personal data.

Due to the above mentioned facts, please read the contents of this Privacy notice.

1. Who is responsible for processing of your personal data?

The controller of your personal data is our company, i.e. Nougat s. r. o., with its registered seat:

We process your personal data in compliance with General Data Protection Regulation (**GDPR**), Act on Personal Data Protection and all other relevant laws.

2. Why is Nougat processing your personal data and what is the purpose and legal basis of such processing?

The categories of personal information we process:

Name, surname, phone number, e-mail, address

Purpose

The processing of personal data takes place in the following activities:

Sales of goods (especially clothing and corresponding accessories) to the end customer through the e-shop www.flace.sk and providing other related services with such sales.

Authorization to process:

Processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Nougat is subject. We get personal information from you.

Legal Basis

Performance of **the contract and execution of pre-contractual measures** in accordance with Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR.

Your personal data are used for the purpose of providing the services and goods as it results from the nature of our business activity including pre-contractual relationships and

the protection and enforcement of Nougat rights and interests stemming from our relationship. This purpose includes mainly the following processing activities:

- ✓ efficient communication relating to the provision of services and goods,
- ✓ ensuring examination of a complaint or claim made by you,
- ✓ ensuring proper performance of services and delivering goods,
- ✓ carrying out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection,
- ✓ providing you with notices about your account (if it was created), including expiration, and renewal notices,
- ✓ notifying you about changes,
- ✓ your e-mail address or phone number can be used by Nougat to communicate with you for verification purposes as well as for other matters related to the Service.

The conclusion and the fulfillment of the contract are possible only if we can process your personal data. In case that the personal data are not provided, our company will not be able to enter into the contract with you and so to provide you the services and goods.

In some circumstances (in case you physically visit our premise at: Obchodná 33/C, 811 06, Bratislava, Slovak republic) your personal data (photos and visual recording showing your image) **can be processed for legitimate interest of Nougat** in accordance with Article 6 (1) (f) GDPR, i.e. for the protection of our rights and interests and for ensuring security in our premises. For this purpose, your personal data can be processed in the following contexts:

- ✓ operation of video surveillance system for the purposes of monitoring and recording our premises accessible to the public in order to ensure your safety and security of our property

In case our company processes your personal data in pursuance of legitimate interests, we always take into account your privacy rights. You as a data subject have the right to object to the processing of your personal data based on the legitimate interests.

3. To whom your personal data can be passed on?

External service providers: To comply with legal and contractual obligations, we cooperate with external service providers (processors) and transfer your personal data to them to the extent necessary for the performance of business activity. In particular, our service providers include IT service providers.

Before any disclosure of your personal data to the processors, we always enter into a written agreement with processors to stipulate the processing of personal data in compliance with principles and obligation stemmed from GDPR.

Courts and Authorities: There are also legal obligations that Nougat can only meet if we provide

your personal data in required extent to the relevant state authorities (f. e. tax authorities, auditors), courts or law enforcement authorities.

4. May your personal data be disclosed to another country (also outside the EU)?

Your personal data are processed within the territory of the Slovak Republic and other states of the European Union. Your personal data can be processed by a country outside of European

Union if this third country has been confirmed by the European Commission as a country with

adequate level of data protection or if other appropriate data protection safeguards exist (for

example, binding corporate privacy rules or EU standard data protection clauses).

5. How long will your personal data be stored?

As soon as Nougat no longer needs your personal data for the processing purposes for which the personal data were collected, it will delete them unless the statute-barred period applies. Certain details and correspondence may be retained until the time limit for claims, in respect of the pre-contractual or contractual relationship has expired or in order to comply with regulatory requirements regarding the retention of such data.

6. What rights do you have as a data subject?

- ✓ If you wish, you can obtain from us the information on all your personal data that we process. In some cases, you have also the right to data portability and so we disclose your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format.
- ✓ Under some circumstances, you may request the restriction of personal data processing as well as rectification and deletion of your personal data. You have the right to submit an objection to the processing of personal data if you think that our data processing is not justified.
- ✓ If you want to complain, please contact us at Facebratislava@gmail.com. You also have the right to file a complaint with the Slovak Data Protection Authority: Úrad na ochranu osobných údajov Slovenskej republiky, Hraničná 12, 820 07 Bratislava, Slovenská republika.
- ✓ Those rights of the data subject (you) are specified in Articles 15 to 21 of the GDPR.

7. Other information:

Personal data may also, in justified cases, be subject to use (processing) for the purpose of dealing with legal matters, including the performance of public authority obligations and monitoring for possible legal protection. Personal data may also be archived for a given public interest, as well as for scientific, historical or statistical research.

Your personal data are not processing by automated decision-making based on personal information.

8. Cookies

A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept (or disable at any time) browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website, unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website.

Our Website utilizes two types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies.

“Session cookies” remain on your device until the moment when they leave the website or exit the web browser. Please note that for some applications or functionality to function correctly, the session cookies must be enabled.

“Persistent cookies” remain on your device for the time specified in the file’s parameters (modification of that time can be made using the browser settings), or until they are manually deleted by you. These cookies facilitate the use of the Website. For example by remembering the previously used resolution or content layout.

Nougat may use external cookies in the following situations:

- ✓ presentation of multimedia content on the website that is streamed, downloaded, or accessed from an external website;
- ✓ presentation of advertisements tailored to your preferences using external websites and services;
- ✓ for sharing content from social networks and using functions made available there.
